Downtown Outreach Ministry's main functions are to provide emergency food, clothing,

and household items. During 2003 9806 people were provided with food,

4688 individuals were clothed, personal care items were given to 1318 people, and

1163 were provided with household items.

In addition to these, 56 were assisted with job training and work uniforms,

41 children attended summer camp, 117 children and parents took part in our parenting

programs. Also 390 individuals were helped with Christmas gifts and food, and a total

of 942 people received winter coats.

Donated goods to Downtown Outreach Ministry include: food, clothing, household items,

cleaning supplies and office supplies. Approximately 65 volunteers donate more than

4600 hours per year to further the cause of Downtown Outreach Ministry.
