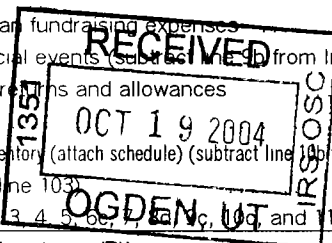

Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi  
Public Support Test  
Facts and Circumstances

The Community Foundation received 28 percent of its support from the public during its first two years of operations. A significant portion of the Community Foundation's early support was from the Maddox Foundation, a private foundation that is committed to establishing the Community Foundation, and whose support is subject to the 2% limit in computing public support.

While a significant portion of the Maddox Foundation's support is in the form of payments to third parties, all such support has been reported on Form 990 by Maddox Foundation and the Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi as charitable contributions made and received. Had Maddox Foundation chosen to list such third-party payments as administrative expenses, and had the Community Foundation not shown these in-kind contributions on its books, the Community Foundation may have in fact met the 33 percent public support requirement.

Other circumstances that show public support for the Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi include the fact that the Community Foundation was organized and has been operated to attract new and additional public support on a continuous basis. While the Community Foundation only had one employee during the 2001-2002 period, that employee operated a program of solicitation of new funds from the general public, particularly in Desoto County communities. Over a dozen "fireside chats" introduced the Community Foundation to over 150 local residents, whose support was actively solicited. Numerous presentations were also made to area civic clubs in two counties to introduce the work of the Community Foundation to the community. As a result, the Community Foundation had received over \$13,000 in direct donations by the end of 2001, with all other support being provided by the Maddox Foundation through third-party payments.

The Community Foundation, very early in its development, printed brochures to introduce the work of the Foundation to the community and solicit donations. A professional videotape was prepared for the same purpose. The Community Foundation also initiated an annual dinner and dance event to serve as a premier fund raising event. This event was initially attended by more than 400 persons, and attracted numerous individual donations from the community. The Community Foundation also attracted other donations to establish endowments at the Foundation for the benefit of local charities such as the local children's theatre group and a historical museum.

During its first two years of operations, the Community Foundation also sought donations at a minimum level of \$5,000 to establish donor-advised funds and build the endowed assets of the Foundation. While many of these initial donations have come from Desoto County, the Foundation is now reaching out to surrounding counties in these efforts.

Since its inception, the Community Foundation has been governed by a Board of Directors who are broadly representative of the Northwest Mississippi community. The Foundation's board members include a variety of professionals and other community leaders, including a dentist, banker, lawyer, small business owner, retired financial services manager, real estate developer, community economic development leader, newspaper owner and minister's wife. As civic leaders, these board members have given their time and energy in extensive volunteer services to organizations such as the local arts council, a health center for uninsured residents, youth sports agencies, a public park development, the literacy council, AIDS prevention, and a host of other community issues. Three volunteers from Desoto County, all actively involved with the Community Foundation as board members or volunteers, received three of the ten Governor's GIVE Awards this year presented by the Mississippi Commission for Volunteer Service.

During the tax year ending 2003, the Community Foundation has hired its first President and CEO, and it continues to expand the services available to the public by continuously offering services to donors in planning gifts and establishing endowed donor-advised funds. Funds have been established with the Foundation to benefit into perpetuity causes such as a children's theatre and a college scholarship sponsored by senior citizens from a retirement home. For three years, the Foundation has also partnered with the Mississippi Center for Nonprofits to conduct the Northwest Mississippi Nonprofit Management Seminar, which this year attracted over 100 participants from across the region.
