# BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF AMERICA CRITERIA FOR QUALIFYING TO RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

#### President Freedom Scholarship:

- Each B&GC Clubhouse/Unit/Branch in the nation is eligible to submit two youth (juniors or seniors) to receive the Presidential Freedom Scholarship. Single unit Clubs provide \$2,000 in scholarship funds through this program; an organization with 10 units provides \$20,000!

- 3. Clubs complete a simple application form and submit it to the provided address by the identified date.
- 4. 4. Club members are notified directly when they receive the Scholarship. This typically occurs in the summer months. Scholarship checks are made out directly to students and the college/university they are will be attending.

#### Specific eligibility requirements for the Smile Ambassador Scholarship include:

- 1. Consistent school attendance and involvement with a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average;
- 2. Involvement in educational activities within the community, describing the services provided, the applicant's role in planning and implementation and the number of people served;
- 3. Consistent Club attendance, leadership and responsibilities assumed within the Club, influence on peers and assistance to staff; and
- 4. Shadowing a local dentist.

#### Scholarships for Club Professionals:

- 1. Demonstrated financial need
- 2. Demonstrated commitment to the profession
- 3. Successful performance in current position
