THE HUNGER PROJECT CARRIED OUT THREE INTEGRATED INITIATIVES FOR AFRICA DURING THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31. 2006, THE EPICENTER STRATEGY, THE AFRICAN WOMAN FOOD FARMER INITIATIVE (AWFFI), AND THE "AIDS AND GENDER INEQUALITY WORKSHOP" TO EMPOWER GRASSROOTS PEOPLE TO KNOW THE FACTS ABOUT AIDS AND CHANGE THE DESTRUCTIVE BEHAVIORS THAT SPREAD THE DISEASE.

THE EPICENTER STRATEGY MOBILIZES THE POPULATION OF CLUSTERS OF VILLAGES TO WORK TOGETHER TO MEET THEIR BASIC NEEDS. CENTERPIECE OF THE STRATEGY IS A MULTIPURPOSE BUILDING CREATED BY THE PEOPLE THEMSELVES THROUGH WHICH THEY CREATE AND OPERATE THEIR OWN PROGRAMS FOR HEALTH, EDUCATION, INCOME-GENERATING ACTIVITIES, NUTRITION, FOOD PRODUCTION AND PROCESSING, FOOD SECURITY AND MICROFINANCE. AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2006, THERE WERE 82 EPICENTERS ENCOMPASSING 3 MILLION PEOPLE AND MORE THAN 1,000 VILLAGES.

THE AFRICAN WOMAN FOOD FARMER INITIATIVE (AWFFI) IS THE MICROFINANCE COMPONENT OF THE EPICENTER STRATEGY. THIS PROGRAM IS COMMITTED TO THE ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT OF AFRICA'S MOST IMPORTANT AND LEAST SUPPORTED PRODUCERS - THE 100 MILLION WOMEN WHO GROW AFRICA'S FOOD. DURING THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2006, AWFFI DISBURSED 12,523 LOANS TOTALING \$733,285.

TO CALL FORTH THE COMMITTED LEADERSHIP NEEDED IN AFRICA, THE HUNGER PROJECT AWARDS THE AFRICA PRIZE FOR LEADERSHIP WHICH, DURING THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2006, WAS AWARDED TO ELLEN JOHNSON SIRLEAF OF LIBERIA, THE FIRST WOMAN ELECTED PRESIDENT ON THE CONTINENT.
