



Part III - Program Service Accomplishments

The Hill House, Incorporated is a non-profit community center serving the Boston community with classes, sports leagues, summer camps and free or low-cost events and activities for children, adults and seniors. 4,825 registrants participated in more than 300 Hill House programs and camps between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2007. Hill House granted about \$20,000 in scholarships during that period. Hill House's communications included three program guides, a summer camp guide, an annual report, email updates to participants, and a website.

Hill House provides opportunities for families to live and grow in the city. Last year, it offered a wide range of free community programs for all ages. Children had the opportunity to have their picture taken with Santa, attend several free holiday parties (around Valentine's Day and similar holidays), participate in our soccer jamboree to kickoff the fall soccer season, and march in our opening-day parade to launch our baseball season (where the Mayor of Boston threw the honorary first pitch). We held six social and community service-oriented events for children between the ages of 11 and 15. Families attended periodic game and movie nights, and they volunteered to cook and serve at our free monthly dinners for neighborhood seniors.

Community service activities organized by the Hill House Outreach Program included drives to collect food, clothing, books, toys, sports equipment, money, and/or other items for such organizations as Neighborhood Action group, the Temporary Home for Women and Children, Safe Passage, Cradles to Crayons, the Massachusetts Coalition for the Homeless, Rosie's Place, Jumpstart, and the Massachusetts Immigration and Refugee Advocacy Coalition.


