THE HISTORIC HILBERT CIRCLE THEATRE, AT THE HEART OF DOWNTOWN INDIANAPOLIS, IS THE HOME OF THE ISO, AND THE ADJACENT SYMPHONY CENTRE OFFICE BUILDING IS ALSO OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE ORGANIZATION. IN ADDITION, THE ORCHESTRA IS IN THE 25TH YEAR OF SUMMER PERFORMANCES ON THE GROUNDS OF CONNER PRAIRIE OUTDOOR HISTORY MUSEUM IN FISHERS, IN, ALONG WITH CONCERTS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR IN VENUES ACROSS THE STATE. THE INDIANAPOLIS SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA ALSO HAS A LEADING ROLE IN MUSIC EDUCATION. IN OVER 100 CLASSROOMS IN THE METROPOLITAN AREA, OUR ARTS EVERYDAY PROGRAM PARTNERS MUSICIANS AND ARTISTS WITH SCHOOLS TO HELP THEM ACHIEVE THEIR CURRICULAR GOALS - TEACHING THEM ABOUT CULTURE, COMMUNICATION, MATH, SCIENCE AND CREATIVITY THROUGH MUSIC AND THE ARTS.
