ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA STATE THAT RECIPIENTS ENTER POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION THE FOLLOWING YEAR. THE SCHOLARSHIP CHECK WILL BE WRITTEN JOINTLY TO THE STUDENT AND THEIR CHOSEN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER LEARNING. SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES WILL BE YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN WHO CONSISTENTLY DEMAND THE BEST OF THEMSELVES THROUGH THEIR VOLUNTEER EFFORTS AND, IN DOING SO, ENRICH THEIR SCHOOL, THEIR HOME OR THEIR COMMUNITY. SOLICITATION OF CANDIDATES WILL BE THROUGH YOUTH-SERVING AGENCIES IN THE SERVICE AREA OF THE UNITED WAY. EACH AGENCY WILL BE ASKED TO SUBMIT NOMINEES IN NOVEMBER OF THE PRECEDING YEAR. APPLICATIONS WILL BE REVIEWED BY A COMMITTEE OF THE VOLUNTEER CENTER. THE TOP FIVE CANDIDATES WILL THEN BE REVIEWED BY THE NELSON FAMILY PRIOR TO FINAL SELECTION. THE UNITED WAY IS PLEASED TO BE A PART OF THIS LOVING TRIBUTE BY THE NELSON FAMILY. WE ARE ALSO PLEASED TO PRESENT THIS SCHOLARSHIP TO ENCOURAGE OUR YOUTH TO GIVE OF THEMSELVES THROUGH ACTS OF VOLUNTEERISM FOR THEIR COMMUNITY.
