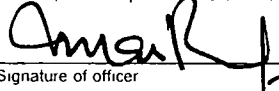

Organization's Primary Exempt Purpose

Our mission and purpose:

20/20 Vision Education Fund was organized to help people learn how they can protect the environment and stop weapons of mass destruction. The founders believed that if busy people were to get involved in the political decisions that affect their lives, they would need simple, grassroots mechanisms not widely available at that time. The slogan "20 minutes to save the Earth" refers to our monthly action postcards which tell 20/20 Vision members where and how to write a letter or take some other action that, with our help, will not take them more than 20 minutes to do. 20/20 Vision Education Fund engages solely in education, outreach and organizing, while its affiliate called the 20/20 Vision National Project engages in lobbying Congress on the legislative component. No lobbying of any sort was conducted by the Education Fund in the year 2005.

20/20 Vision Education Fund has long been known for its ability to educate and activate thousands of people each month, generating tangible, timely actions on issues of national and international significance. Its public education programs stress the interdependency of a strong environment and strong global security. We educate individuals, government decision makers, and their communities on issues such as nuclear and biological weapons, air pollution, fuel efficiency and energy policy, safe food and children's health. We have had a lead role in supporting new regulations to restrict pollution from SUVs, light trucks, diesel trucks and diesel buses.

The current campaign priorities are to build nationwide grassroots support for:

- o A ban on US funding for the development of new nuclear weapons
- o Continuation of the current ten-year ban on testing nuclear weapons in the US
- o Reduced oil consumption
- o Stronger international measures to control bio-weapons
- o Higher fuel economy standards for SUVs, light trucks, and cars
- o Tougher emission standards for big diesel construction and farm equipment
- o Rejection of the unworkable "star wars" system of national missile defense
- o No weakening of the Clean Air Act
- o New restrictions on emissions of health-threatening mercury to the environment
- o Protection for our nation's last undeveloped wild lands and forests

20/20 Vision has built coalitions and spearheaded a wide range of outreach and education strategies on these issues. We have mobilized our grassroots network through personal letters, on-line activism, town meetings, student outreach, and regional organizing in target states.

Our work on oil addiction issues has been closely coordinated with other national groups, including the Natural Resources Defense Council and the Union of Concerned Scientists, among others. On disarmament issues, 20/20 Vision works closely with Physicians for Social Responsibility, the Arms Control Association, Union of Concerned Scientists, Friends Committee on National Legislation, Council for a Livable World, and many faith-based groups. We have also established dozens of partnerships with faith groups and progressive businesses, both of which regularly disseminate our information.
