**Sports, Competition & Training - The Organization trains volunteer coaches in working with special needs individuals and in sport specific training instructions. Approximately 80 training schools are held throughout the state annually in order to meet these training needs. Athletes participate in a number of the 90 competitions held annually at the local, parish, area and state level, offering competitive events in more than 20 sports. Every two years, athletes can qualify to compete in either the Summer World Games or the Winter World Games, giving them further opportunities to grow and meet new people from other countries and cultures. This program also includes "Got SOLA?" and "Project UNIFY", which are an array of programs through which the athletes are provided with the tools and training to become healthier, grow in self confidence through leadership programs, and include families and other individuals without disabilities in the inclusive activities. Healthy Athletes is a program which provides free dental, hearing, and vision screenings, as well as healthy lifestyle training for the athletes. The Young Athletes Program provides children, ages 2-7 years, early childhood intervention opportunities through sports development. Family involvement activities and background screenings of volunteers are also large components of this program.**

**Communications & Marketing - The Organization has a goal of transparency and keeping the public informed of the services provided to Louisiana citizens with intellectual disabilities.
