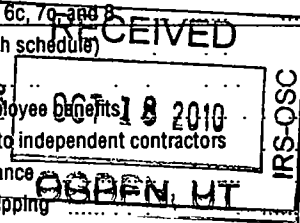

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM - DURING 2009, THE FOUNDATION PROVIDED EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, HOPE, COMPASSION AND LOVE TO 46 CHILDREN FIGHTING CANCER. THE FOUNDATION'S SUPPORT BENEFITED 194 FAMILY MEMBERS. FROM 2006 THROUGH 2009, THE FOUNDATION'S FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SERVED APPROXIMATELY 610 CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS WHOSE LIVES WERE IMPACTED BY PEDIATRIC CANCER. THE FOUNDATION IS PROUD OF ITS ABILITY TO SOLVE THE IMMEDIATE NEEDS OF CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES WHO ARE STRUGGLING TO SURVIVE WHAT FOR MANY IS THE MOST DIFFICULT CRISIS OF THEIR LIVES. THE FOUNDATION'S BUDGET GREW APPROXIMATELY 70% DURING 2009 THANKS TO THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF GENEROUS INDIVIDUALS, PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS AND CORPORATIONS.

ONE OF THE FOUNDATION'S PARTNER HOSPITALS, CHRIS EVERT CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL AT BROWARD GENERAL MEDICAL CENTER, NAMED THE RECEPTION AREA OF ITS NEW PEDIATRIC HEMATOLOGY AND ONCOLOGY CENTER AFTER THE JESSICA JUNE CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION IN RECOGNITION OF THE FOUNDATION'S SUPPORT OF ITS PATIENTS.

THE JESSICA JUNE CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION SERVES THE PEDIATRIC ONCOLOGY PATIENTS OF ALL OF SOUTH FLORIDA'S CHILDREN'S HOSPITALS.

ADVOCACY PROGRAM - THROUGH OUR ADVOCACY PROGRAM JJCCF RAISED ADDITIONAL FUNDS THROUGH MEDIA PARTNERSHIPS, NEWSLETTER AND SPECIAL EVENTS. THE FOUNDATION PARTNERED WITH WPLG-LOCAL 10 NEWS CARE FORCE TO RAISE AWARENESS FOR THE FINANCIAL HARDSHIPS EXPERIENCED BY FAMILIES IN CRISIS ENDURING PEDIATRIC CANCER AND RAISED FUNDS FOR A SINGLE MOM OF FOUR CHILDREN IN NEED OF TRANSPORTATION FOR HER CHILD MISSING CANCER TREATMENT. THIS MOM HAD TO RELY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION TO CROSS COUNTY LINES FROM THEIR HOME IN HIALEAH-DADE COUNTY TO JOE DIMAGGIO CHILDRENS HOSPITAL-BROWARD COUNTY. THE OUTCOME WAS A FULLY PAID NEW CAR INCLUDING INSURANCE FOR THIS FAMILY OF FIVE.

ALSO, JJCCF'S ADVOCACY PROGRAM RAISED OVER \$16,000 FOR A SINGLE DAD OF THREE CHILDREN SO THAT HIS DAUGHTER COULD HAVE A CONSULTATION AT M.D. ANDERSON, AND FAMILY COULD HAVE ACCESS TO BASIC NEEDS DURING A DIFFICULT FIVE MONTH PERIOD. THE WASIE FOUNDATION AND OUR MEDIA PARTNERS AT CBS NEIGHBORS 4 NEIGHBORS, SUN-SENTINEL AND THE MIAMI HERALD HELPED US RAISE FUNDS FOR THIS 16 YEAR OLD FIGHTING OSTEOSARCOMA.

THE JESSICA JUNE CHILDREN'S CANCER FOUNDATION (JJCCF) PROVIDES EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR CHILDREN FIGHTING CANCER TO ENSURE ACCESS TO BASIC HUMAN NECESSITIES. ADDITIONALLY, THE FOUNDATION ADVOCATES FOR AND RAISES AWARENESS OF CHILDHOOD CANCER.

A DIAGNOSIS OF CHILDHOOD CANCER CREATES AN IMMEDIATE MEDICAL AND EMOTIONAL CRISIS WHILE ALSO CREATING A FINANCIAL CRISIS FOR MANY FAMILIES. JJCCF IS COMMITTED TO PROVIDING EMERGENCY FINANCIAL RELIEF TO HELP FAMILIES ENDURING PEDIATRIC CANCER PAY FOR EVERYDAY NECESSITIES SUCH AS MEDICAL, UTILITIES, RENT, MORTGAGE, CAR, GAS AND GROCERIES. THIS DIRECT AND TANGIBLE TEMPORARY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE JJCCF PROVIDES IS VITAL TO THE SURVIVAL OF THESE CHILDREN WHILE THEY RECEIVE CANCER TREATMENT.

AFTER A CHILD IS DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER, A PARENT MOST OFTEN HAS TO GIVE UP THEIR JOB AND SOURCE OF INCOME TO BECOME A FULLTIME CAREGIVER. WHILE THEIR CHILD IS IN TREATMENT, A CHILD IS CONTINUOUSLY IN AND OUT OF THE HOSPITAL, HAS A COMPROMISED IMMUNE SYSTEM AND MOST OFTEN HAS TO BE HOME SCHOOLED. ALTHOUGH THE FINANCIAL CRISIS IS TEMPORARY, IT REQUIRES IMMEDIATE ATTENTION SO THAT A CHILD HAS A BETTER CHANCE OF SURVIVING. MOST OF THE CHILDREN WHO QUALIFY FOR OUR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM COME FROM A SINGLE PARENT HOUSEHOLD AND THE CHILD/FAMILY HAS QUALIFIED FOR GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS SUCH AS MEDICAID AND SUPPLEMENTAL SECURITY INCOME. QUALIFYING FOR GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE MEANS THE INCOME LEVEL OF THESE FAMILIES FALLS BELOW THE FEDERAL POVERTY THRESHOLD.
