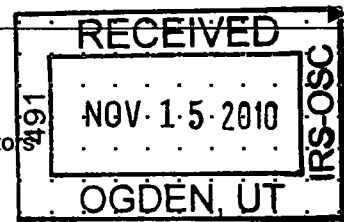

Science Enrichment

Ecology in Classrooms & Outdoors (ECO) connects students to the world around them through Science Enrichment Programs. ECO sends pairs of Scientists in Residence into individual elementary school classrooms to facilitate a series of hands-on ecology lessons. Lessons occur both indoors and outside, and are aligned with state educational standards.

ECO Science Enrichment Programs often include a service-learning project, through which students apply the knowledge gained in ECO lessons while simultaneously improving their community. ECO also provides interested teachers with optional extension activities based on concepts taught through Science Enrichment Program lessons. ECO Science Enrichment Programs are designed to occur year after year, resulting in an additional 60 hours of science inquiry during a student's elementary career.

In the 2009-2010 school year, four ECO programs reached 600 students in 17 classrooms. Science Enrichment Programs are funded primarily through the support of Parent Teacher Associations and local foundations.

Field Trips

ECO Science Enrichment Programs make the most of a school's natural resources by taking walking field trips to local wetlands, creeks, and streams where students can explore the ecology of their environmental community.

ECO Scientists in Residence also arrange and facilitate full-day activities at field trip sites away from school grounds. In coordinating these field trips, ECO often partners with other organizations and businesses. Field trips may include service-learning components.

In 2009-2010, ECO facilitated 12 field trips.
