The Foundation serves as a fiscal sponsor overseeing program operations and receiving and administering funds for projects and grants associated with the California Community Colleges and related public agencies in California The Early College High School Initiative forms partnerships between small high schools and postsecondary institutions to give underrepresented youth the opportunity to earn a high school diploma and at least two years of college credit within five years at no cost The Nursing Resource Center is a suite of internet-based services that provides centralized, customer-focused services for schools of nursing and clinical agencies. The goal of the NRC is to expand capacity for nursing education nationwide through the use of the Centralized Clinical Placement System to manage clinical placements and the Centralized Faculty Resource Center to identify and attract qualified nursing faculty The Foundation's Nursing Investment Fund supports nursing students and Community College nursing programs throughout the state.
