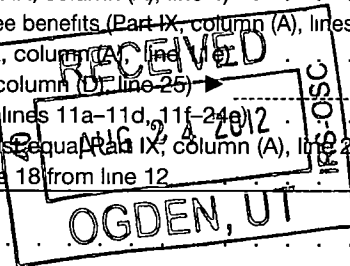

The Journey Home provides basic needs resources such as meals, food staples, clothing, emergency (vouchers) and supportive housing, hygiene and laundry facilities and supplies, computer lab and employment readiness coaching, transportation assistance, rent and utility assistance, case management and the like to equip the homeless and disadvantaged of Rutherford county, Tennessee for self-sufficiency and reintegration into community life.

The Journey Home provided hunger relief to the homeless and needy in the community through our Community Cafe' program. During 2011, we served breakfast Mondays through Fridays, lunch Mondays through Saturdays and supper on Sunday and Monday. This program provided 32,115 meals in 2011. Additionally, the Community Cafe' program provided boxes of food staples, dairy, and produce to clients in need. Some 3,800 food boxes were distributed during 2011 at our outreach center. Much of the produce was raised at our community garden while other food was both purchased and received as in-kind donations. The Community Cafe' bread room also provided an abundance of bread and pastries daily that clients take with them when they leave the center. All of this is provided at no charge to the clients. The small revenue was from the sale of produce at the clients' Community Garden.

4b (Code: 624200) (Expenses \$ 135,378 including grants of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ ) (Revenue \$ 40,347 )  
The Journey Home provided housing, case management and supportive services through our Supportive Housing program. The program not only provided housing for 6 months to 1 year for 47 clients during 2011, but assistance with life skills in areas such as budgeting, parenting, conflict management, employment readiness, living in community, and the like. We also assist clients with transportation issues, working with the school system and collaborate with other agencies to help them gain mainstream benefits. The program was increased to 16 scattered-site housing units by the end of the year and was a full occupancy. More than half of the housing units serve families with children and more than half of the units serve persons with some type of long-term disabling condition.

The Journey Home assisted the homeless and needy in our community with clothing, laundry, and hygiene items at our outreach center. Clients can wash up to two loads of clothes weekly and shop in our clothes closet Mondays through Fridays. While all clothing taken is tracked, there is no charge to the client for any of these services. Over 25,000 clothing items were re-distributed during 2011. Clients are also supplied with toiletry items including soap, shampoo, razors, tooth care, combs, feminine hygiene items, diapers, and the like through this program. These are items that are difficult to budget on limited or inconsistent funds and cannot be purchased with food stamps. Shoes and uniforms are also provided for adults with new jobs and children for school. A hot shower, proper hygiene and clean clothes go a long way to establishing self-worth and the type of appearance that helps clients gain acceptance and often a job in the community.

Expenses only include direct costs since it is difficult to the classify significant indirect costs such as utilities for the laundry equipment. Facility cost is significant for these programs also as the entire building is used for direct client services. Admin space is off-site in a donated office, so all building overhead is directly used to provide these services.
