1851 Center for Constitutional Law Form 990: List of Actions Taken pursuant to Exempt Purpose in 2013

- 1. Liberty Coins v. Ohio Department of Commerce. This is a case on behalf of a small business owner to vindicate the right to advertise, freedom from vague and arbitrary licensing laws and regulations, and freedom from sweeping searches and seizures of business property. We prevailed in federal court; and the state appealed to Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals.
- 2. ProgressOhio v. JobsOhio. This is a case on behalf of an advocacy organization to establish Ohioans' legal standing, in their capacities as citizens and taxpayers, to enforce structural limits on government expressed in the Ohio Constitution court.
- 3. Walker v. City of Toledo. This is a case on behalf of a class of Ohio drivers to vindicate due process and the right to judicial oversight, as against automated traffic cameras. This case was just briefed to the Ohio Supreme Court.
- 4. Citizens in Charge v. Husted. This is a case on behalf of Ohioans for Workplace Freedom and Citizens in Charge Foundation to vindicate freedom of contract and free speech and associational rights of Ohioans through a challenge to limits on initiative and referendum rights that disparately harm right-wing grass-roots efforts). 1851 has prevailed in this case, and the law is enjoined.
- 5. In re: Sarah Hershberger. This is a case to vindicate parental rights and choice on behalf of Amish parents whose daughter has contracted cancer. The state had sought to take their daughter and force chemotherapy on her after the family withdrew her from that treatment, believing that the chemo was killing her, and sought to first try an alternative treatment before resuming chemo.
- 6. Sanborn v. Indian Hill Board of Education. This is a case on behalf of an Ohio school district's property taxpayers, to vindicate their right to be free from unlawful taxation, after the school district used accounting gimmickry to raise property taxes without the requisite vote of the public.
- 7. Susan B. Anthony List v. Driehaus. This is a case pending before the United States Supreme Court challenging to power of Ohio Elections Commission to initiate legal proceedings in response to political statements by Ohioans. These proceedings have a disparate impact on political amateurs, and are used by incumbents to stifle speech and competition. We are a key amicus party in this case.
- 8. Cleveland Right to Life v. State of Ohio Controlling Board. This was a separation of powers challenge to an administrative Board's constitutional authority to effectuate Medicaid expansion over the objection of the Ohio General Assembly.
- 9. Corsi v. Ohio Elections Commission. This was a case to vindicate the First Amendment rights of an Ohio blogger who political opponents (local officials) claimed was operating as a Political Action Committee without license and registration, because he was blogging about politics. The

- Ohio Supreme Court refused to hear the case, 4-3, and the U.S. Supreme Court denied cert. (We partnered with the Center for Competitive Politics).
- 10. Sunoco v. Simonetti. We represented a property owner who was sued by a private pipeline company seeking to take his property through eminent domain.
- 11. The 1851 Center's Director discussed constitutional rights at a myriad of live events, and through a myriad of media outlets, including television, radio, and print.
