CSS'S HEALTH INITIATIVES DEPARTMENT CONDUCTS HEALTH COVERAGE POLICY RESEARCH, ADVOCATES FOR QUALITY AFFORDABLE COVERAGE FOR ALL, AND PROVIDES EDUCATION AND DIRECT HEALTH COVERAGE ASSISTANCE TO NEW YORK CONSUMERS. SINCE NOVEMBER 2010, THE COMMUNITY HEALTH ADVOCATES (CHA) PROGRAM HAS SERVED AS THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S DESIGNATED CONSUMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. CHA'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS DURING FY 2015 INCLUDE HELPED INDIVIDUALS THROUGH ONE-ON-ONE ASSISTANCE AND EDUCATION SESSIONS IN 31,839 CASES. CHA PARTNERED WITH COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS. IN 2013, CSS WAS AWARDED A GRANT TO LEAD NEW YORK'S LARGEST NAVIGATOR NETWORK, CSS'S NAVIGATOR NETWORK (CNN), WITH 38 COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION PARTNERS. NAVIGATORS HELP CONSUMERS ENROLL IN COVERAGE THROUGH THE NY STATE OF HEALTH MARKETPLACE. CNN HELPED CONSUMERS IN 62,528 CASES DURING FY 2015. THE HEALTH INITIATIVES DEPARTMENT HAS 25 TRAINED AND ACTIVE VOLUNTEERS SINCE DECEMBER 2014, CSS HAS ADMINISTERED THE INDEPENDENT CONSUMER ADVOCACY NETWORK (ICAN), NEW YORK'S MEDICAID MANAGED LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSPROGRAM. IN FY 2015, ICAN SERVED CONSUMERS IN 13,968 CASES WITH 8 COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND FIVE SPECIALIST AGENCIES THROUGH THE HARLEM HEALTH ADVOCACY PARTNERS PROGRAM, CSS STAFF SERVED CONSUMERS IN 512 DIRECT ASSISTANCE CASES AND 430 PRESENTATION CASES.

RETIRED & SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM (RSVP) THE RSVP PROGRAM RECRUITS, TRAINS, PLACES AND RECOGNIZES ABOUT 3,000 OLDER ADULT VOLUNTEERS THROUGHOUT THE FIVE BOROUGHES WHO SERVE AT OVER 300 NONPROFIT AGENCIES AND PROPRIETARY HEALTH CARE FACILITIES. RSVP CONDUCTS ITS OWN PROGRAMS IN THE AREAS OF FINANCIAL COUNSELING AND COACHING, MENTORING TROUBLED YOUTH AND CHILDREN OF INCARCERATED PARENTS, BENEFIT COUNSELING AND DISASTER PREPAREDNESS. RSVP ALSO RECRUITS AND PLACES VOLUNTEERS AT PARTNERING AGENCIES. AMONG THE SERVICES THEY PROVIDE ARE DELIVERING MEALS TO HOMEBOUND OLDER ADULTS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES, PREPARING AND SERVING MEALS AT SOUP KITCHENS, FOOD PANTRIES AND SENIOR CENTERS, SERVING AS CONVERSATION PARTNERS IN ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE PROGRAMS, TUTORING IN ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM, SERVING AS OMBUDSMEN TO ENSURE THE RIGHTS OF NURSING HOME AND LONG TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENTS, SERVING AS FRIENDLY VISITORS TO NURSING HOME RESIDENTS, HOSPITAL PATIENTS AND HOMEBOUND OLDER ADULTS, SERVING AS DOCENTS AND PROVIDING ASSISTANCE AT MUSEUMS, PARKS, BOTANICAL GARDENS AND ZOOS. RSVP HOLDS SEVERAL RECOGNITION EVENTS HONORING VOLUNTEER ACHIEVEMENTS EACH YEAR DURING THE PERIOD 7/1/14 - 6/30/15, 2,477 VOLUNTEERS SERVED IN THE RSVP PROGRAM.

EXPERIENCE CORPS MOBILIZES OLDER ADULTS WITH THE COMMUNITY TO PROVIDE TUTORIAL SERVICES TO CHILDREN WHO ARE IN DANGER OF ACADEMIC FAILURE. DURING THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR, THE OBJECTIVE AND GOALS OF THE PROGRAM WAS TO CREATE NINE TEAMS OF OLDER ADULTS VOLUNTEERS AND PLACE THEM IN NINE SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE A MINIMUM OF 35 TUTORIAL SESSIONS TO OUR ONE ON ONE STUDENTS AND PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO TEACHERS IN 65 CLASSROOMS ACROSS NINE SCHOOLS. EXPERIENCE CORPS RECRUITED TRAINED AND PLACED AND RECOGNIZED 85 OLDER ADULT VOLUNTEERS THROUGHOUT THREE BOROUGHES. IN FISCAL 2015 SCHOOL YEAR, VOLUNTEERS PROVIDED 27,397 HOURS OF TUTORING TO 1029 CHILDREN IN NINE SCHOOLS IN THE BRONX, QUEENS AND MANHATTAN. EC VOLUNTEERS WORK 16 HOURS A WEEK FOR 4 DAYS A WEEK FROM OCTOBER - JUNE. VOLUNTEERS RECEIVED 32 HOURS OF PRE-SERVICE AND ONGOING TRAINING FOR THE YEAR. VOLUNTEERS WERE TRAINING USING THE TUTORING CURRICULUM BOOK BUDDIES. STUDENTS RECEIVED INDIVIDUALIZED LESSON PLANS AND THIS YEAR THEY RECEIVED 11,403 LESSONS/SESSIONS OF TUTORING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 AND THEY READ A TOTAL OF 6,593 BOOKS. STUDENTS' ASSESSMENTS REVEALED THAT CHILDREN AT EACH SCHOOL MADE SIGNIFICANT ACADEMIC STRIDES AND 100% PERCENT OF THOSE SERVED THROUGH ONE ON ONE TUTORING IMPROVED THEIR PALS SCORES, THE MAJORITY OF WHOM JUMPED AT LEAST ONE READING LEVEL. OVERALL PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN PRE AND POST SCORES BY BOROUGH WAS AS FOLLOWS: 80% FOR KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS, 77% FOR 1ST-2ND GRADERS IN THE BRONX, 204% FOR KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS, 42% FOR 1ST AND 2ND GRADERS IN QUEENS, IN MANHATTAN, 65% FOR 1ST GRADE AND 18% FOR 2ND GRADE. TEACHERS SURVEY OUTCOMES WERE ALSO INCREDIBLY POSITIVE. TEACHERS REPORTED THAT 67% OF THE STUDENTS DEMONSTRATED IMPROVED CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR AND 91% OF TEACHERS REPORTED THAT VOLUNTEERS HAD A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON IMPROVING STUDENT PERFORMANCE.
