During tax year 2015 there was a reduction in assets greater than 25% resulting in a substantial contraction of the General Motors Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation"). The substantial contraction is due to excess distributions made during the tax year, which were in far excess of income received by the Foundation during the tax year. The book income during tax year 2015 was \$476,752, and total expenses and distributions for charitable purposes were \$30,939,292.

Furthermore, with regard to the specific information required by the Internal Revenue Service the Foundation is providing the additional supporting information:

1. A certified copy of the liquidation plan, resolution, etc. (if any) and all amendments or supplements that were not previously filed. The Foundation does not have a current formal liquidation plan.
2. A schedule that lists the names and addresses of all recipients of assets. Of the \$30,939,292, \$29,981,481 were grants paid to charitable organizations. The list of charitable organizations receiving funding is provided with the Form 990PF.
3. An explanation of the nature and fair market value of the assets distributed to each recipient. The Foundation distributed cash so there is not a requirement to determine fair market value.
