



This publication educates the public on how they can help support efforts on the protection of national parklands. NPT also conducts its annual bipartisan Bruce F. Vento Public Service Award event to honor a public servant for his or her commitment to the environment, and his or her service, skill and innovation in support of our public lands, and to provide the public with information on such service. In June 2017, the award reci pient was Senator Lamar Alexander from Tennessee. NPT also conducts its American Park Experience Award event to recognize an individual or group that has made outstanding contributions to enhance the awareness and appreciation of our nation's parks, wildlife refuges and historic landmarks and to provide the public with information on such contributions.
