THEY FIND SOLACE, PROTECTION, AND COMPANIONSHIP THROUGH THEIR PETS. THEY CARE FOR THEIR PETS ON LIMITED RESOURCES SO THEY THEMSELVES HAVE LESS. OUR TASK, NATIONWIDE, IS TO FEED AND PROVIDE BASIC EMERGENCY VETERINARY CARE TO THEIR PETS AND THUS RELIEVE THE ANGUISH AND ANXIETY OF THE HOMELESS WHO CANNOT PROVIDE FOR THEIR PETS.

PET FOOD, AND SUPPLIES: NON-CASH AWARDS OF PET FOOD (154,688.97 LBS), PET SUPPLIES WERE DISTRIBUTED TO NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS (MOSTLY FOOD BANKS) ACROSS THE COUNTRY TO ASSIST WITH THE FEEDING OF PETS BELONGING TO THE HOMELESS AND POOR. PET FOOD AND SUPPLIES THAT WERE PURCHASED BY POTW WERE GIVEN TO THE NON-PROFITS. SLEEPING CRATES WERE SHIPPED TO NON-PROFIT HOMELESS SHELTERS.

EMERGENCY VETERINARY CARE: IN 2021, THERE WERE 892 INVOICES TOTALING \$320,836.80 (AVERAGE OF \$359.68) PAID TO 212 HOSPITALS IN 24 STATES WITH A TOTAL OF 684 PETS TREATED, 88% WERE DOGS AND 12% WERE CATS OF THE HOMELESS. SOME HOSPITALS GAVE A DISCOUNT. 61% OF THE CALLERS WERE WOMEN, 5% VETERANS. THE AVERAGE TIME THEY HAD BEEN HOMELESS WAS 2 YEARS AND 9 MONTHS. 32% WERE LIVING IN THEIR VEHICLES.
