The remaining expenditures were for AAN staff and vendor work on political matters, including strategic planning, research, polling, and data collection. During the tax year, the Network also ran grassroots lobbying communications and similar messages on issues of importance to the organization such as improving the Medicare Part D market with commonsense reforms while opposing socialist government price controls, vociferously opposing Build Back Better and its reckless tax hikes and wasteful spending, opposing wasteful spending and misplaced priorities in the American Recovery Act, and weighing in on other key policies and legislation from a center-right stand point related to fiscal, budgetary, tax, regulatory, and constitutional issues.
