City of Los AngelesThe litigation centers on the civil rights of unhoused individuals who are living in tents and makeshift encampments in the City of Los Angeles. The litigation challenges the seizure and destruction of unhoused individuals' belongings. The case challenges the constitutionality of an ordinance in Los Angeles that allows the City to seize and destroy unhoused residents' belongings. Plaintiffs allege that the ordinance violates the Fourth and Fourteenth amendment. Defendant appealed to the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals.In 2021, the preliminary injunction was upheld by the 9th Circuit.Soja v. LightbourneThis case was filed to challenge the Department of Social Services policy of refusing to reimburse recipients who's CalFresh benefits are stolen by electronic theft.The trial court decided in favor of the respondent Department of Social Services. Petitioners appealed and the Court of Appeal decided in favor of petitioners/appellants. The case was remanded to the trial court to issue the writ and judgment. As a direct result of this case the State of California revised their policy to allow for replacement and/or reimbursement of CalFresh benefits that are electronically stolen. LAFLA's client's stolen benefits were replaced.GHP Management Corporation, et.al. v. City of Los Angeles, et.al.Plaintiff Landlord-Developer has sued the City of Los Angeles alleging that policies protecting renters impacted by the COVID-19 from eviction during the pandemic amount to an unlawful government taking. Intervenor's position is that the policy does not amount to an unlawful taking. LAFLA and co-counsel represent tenants rights organizations who represent the interests of individuals who are rent burdened and unable to pay their rent during the COVID-19 pandemic. LAFLA's clients sought to intervene in the federal lawsuit in order to ensure the interests of low income tenants were represented, and the motion to intervene was granted.LA Alliance for Human Rights, et.al. v. City of Los Angeles, et.al.Property owners are challenging a federal Settlement Agreement signed by the City of Los Angeles over alleged nuisance conditions in Skid Row. LAFLA represents intervenors, who seek to protect the civil rights of individuals experiencing homelessness. Plaintiffs brought an injunction that would have disrupted services for unhoused individuals, that was appealed to the 9th Circuit Court.LAFLA successfully argued in the 9th Circuit and the injunction was denied.Mekan v. Johnson, California Department of Social ServicesLAFLA represents a caretaker relative of a child in the dependency system who suffered sex discrimination and due process violations in the termination of her Resource Family Approval (RFA). Caregivers for foster children must have their home approved under the RFA process, a five-part process involving a background check, mandatory training, a home inspection, and a psychosocial assessment. Denial of RFA has several consequences, including denial of foster care benefits. If this case is successful, indigent children whose relative caretakers are denied RFA based on sex discrimination will, among other things, have access to foster care benefits.LAFLA successfully obtained a stay of the RFA termination.
