The scholarship program attracts thousands of students each year, each of whom learns about President Coolidge and his values through the course of applying for the scholarship. The Coolidge Foundation conducts a rigorous, multi-stage, review process that culminates with interviews with a finalist jury. Since 2016, thirty-two Coolidge Scholarships have been awarded.
