FOUNDED IN 1900, THIS PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVES THE BOROUGH OF CARLISLE, SEVEN TOWNSHIPS IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY, THE CARLISLE BARRACKS (HOME OF THE U.S. ARMY WAR COLLEGE), THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY PRISON, AND SERVES AS THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY LAW LIBRARY. ITS MISSION IS TO EMPOWER LIFELONG LEARNING BY MEETING THE COMMUNITY'S NEEDS THROUGH ROBUST, HIGH-QUALITY, AND DIVERSE COLLECTIONS, PROGRAMS, AND SERVICES. IN KEEPING WITH THE LIBRARY'S MISSION, THE BOSLER MEMORIAL LIBRARY PROVIDES OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL PEOPLE WITHOUT RESTRICTION. THE LIBRARY CELEBRATES THE DIVERSITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY IT SERVES AND STRIVES TO SERVE ALL MEMEBERS OF THE COMMUNITY EQUALLY. WITH MORE THAN 179,796 VISITS IN 2023, THE BOSLER MEMORIAL LIBRARY IS ONE OF THE BUSIEST LIBRARIES IN CUMBERLAND COUNTY. IT IS A MEMBER OF THE CUMBERLAND COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM, WHICH

IN 2023, THE INTERNET COMPUTERS WERE USED MORE THAN 12,535 TIMES, AND THE WIFI WAS USED MORE THAN 12,675 TIMES. IN 2023, MORE THAN 5,750 ADULTS ATTENDED 413 PROGRAMS PROVIDED BY THE BOSLER MEMORIAL LIBRARY ON A WIDE RANGE OF TOPICS THAT OFFERED PARTICIPANTS ACTIVE LIFELONG LEARNING EXPERIENCES. THESE EXPERIENCES EMPOWERED PARTICIPANTS TO BE ENGAGED AND KNOWLEDGEABLE CITIZENS OF THEIR COMMUNITY. IN ADDITION, THE LIBRARY PROVIDES MEETING ROOM SPACE, SMALL GROUP STUDY ROOM SPACE, AND TUTORING ROOM SPACE FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC. IN 2023, THESE SPACES WERE USED BY MORE THAN 4,950 PEOPLE. THE LIBRARY HAS ALSO BEGUN EXPANDING ITS OUTREACH TO THE COMMUNITY, RECOGNIZING THAT GOING OUT INTO THE COMMUNITY IS AN IMPORTANT COMPONENT OF SERVICE. IN 2023, THE LIBRARY PROVIDED 500 OUTREACH PROGRAMS ATTENDED BY MORE THAN 17,100 PEOPLE.

THEY ALSO PRODUCE INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SUCH AS BIBLIOGRAPHIES, PATHFINDERS, AND "HOW-TO" GUIDES FOR THE PUBLIC. THE INFORMATION SERVICES LIBRARIANS ALSO PROMOTE LIBRARY RESOURCES THROUGH DISPLAYS AND PRINTED MATERIALS. THE INFORMATION SERVICES STAFF PARTICIPATE IN THE COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT PROCESS OF SELECTING MATERIALS FOR THE LIBRARY'S COLLECTION. WHEN DESIRED MATERIALS ARE NOT AVAILABLE IN THE LIBRARY'S COLLECTION, THE INFORMATION SERVICES STAFF PROVIDE INTERLIBRARY LOAD SERVICE THAT ALLOWS PATRONS TO OBTAIN ITEMS FROM OTHER LIBRARIES. IN 2023, THE INFORMATION SERVICES STAFF ANSWERED MORE THAN 27,900 REFERENCE QUESTIONS.

THESE PROGRAMS ARE BENCHMARKED TO THE NATIONAL LEARNING STANDARDS TO ENSURE HIGH QUALITY LEARNING EXPERIENCE WHILE ENCOURAGING TECHNOLOGY SKILL DEVELOPMENT. IN 2023, THESE AWE EARLY LEARNING COMPUTER STATIONS WERE USED BY CHILDREN MORE THAN 10,869 TIMES.
