IN FY24, LWVEF PROVIDED THIS INFORMATION IN BOTH ENGLISH AND SPANISH LANGUAGES TO VOTERS IN ALL 50 STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA. THROUGHOUT THE FISCAL YEAR, JULY 2023-JUNE 2024, NEARLY 4.5 MILLION PEOPLE ACCESSED VOTE411 FOR VOTER EDUCATION AND INFORMATION PURPOSES. LWVEF REGISTERED OVER 28,300 VOTERS THROUGH THIS ONLINE PLATFORM. LWVEF ALSO INCLUDES BALLOT INFORMATION FOR EVERY ELECTION CYCLE ON VOTE411. IN THE RUNUP TO THE GENERAL ELECTION THE NATIONAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LEAGUES REACHED OUT TO OVER 40,000 CANDIDATES REQUESTING THAT THEY ANSWER THE LEAGUE'S NONPARTISAN QUESTIONS FOR VOTE411'S ONLINE VOTER GUIDE. LWVEF CONTACTED MORE THAN 5.3 MILLION VOTERS VIA CANVAS, EMAIL, MAIL, PHONE, AND TEXT DURING THIS TIMEFRAME TO PROVIDE THEM WITH CRITICAL ELECTION INFORMATION, INCLUDING HOW TO MAKE A VOTING PLAN, FIND THEIR POLLING PLACE, LEARN ABOUT EARLY AND ABSENTEE VOTING OPTIONS, AND ENCOURAGE THEM TO EXERCISE THEIR RIGHT TO VOTE. ADDITIONALLY, LWVEF REACHED 10.27 MILLION PEOPLE THROUGH VOTE411-SPECIFIC SOCIAL MEDIA POSTS, AND PEOPLE VIEWED EDUCATIONAL CONTENT ON LWV.ORG MORE THAN 80,000 TIMES.
