PARTICPANTS RECEIVED HANDS ON TRAINING/SUPPORT WITH BASIC CAR CARE MAINTENANCE BY TRUTECH AUTOMOTIVE IN WAYNESBORO. AT THE END OF THE SESSIONS AN EMERGENCY ROADSIDE KIT WAS GIVEN TO EACH HOUSEHOLD AND A 150 GIFT CERTIFICATE FOR A REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT PART FOR THEIR VEHICLE. CAPPED AT 10 PARTICIPANTS.
